


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Seat Belt

When mounting and adjusting your harness, it is vital that the Sternum Strap, if applicable, sit across the chest and is a minimum of 4" below the neckline. Harness, Shoulder, Lap Belts, and Anti-Submarine Belt (if applicapable) must be firmly tightened against body **at all times** to help prevent injury or death. Effectiveness and longevity of this equipment is directly related to how it is installed, used, and maintained. User assumes all responsibility to ensure all warnings and directions are followed.


***** SB-5 will use M12 x 35mm Bolt and M12 Flange Nut only when installing.

Mounting Brackets are to be installed at an angle that is the same as the direction of pull. Preferred mounting is as shown above. Ensure there are no welds around Belt or Belt Hardware. All mounting points are to be directly to frame of vehicle chassis. Belts are to be mounted so that drivers forward and upward movement are limited.

In the event of an accident, belts will move in direction of impact. Ensure there is adequate clearance around belts to avoid any abrasions or cuts. Keep belts away from all heat sources such as muffler, exhaust components, etc.

OIMPORTANT Be sure to lock Slide Adjusters as shown. Slide Adjusters should be located as close as possible to the bolt in Mounting Bracket. In order to properly lock belts into place, and prevent loosening while driving or during an accident, it is very important to follow these attaching instructions.

Inspect Seat Belt and components yearly. Replace any damaged/worn components as needed.
